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## Swimming Victoria Membership

Swimming Victoria offers annual membership from **1 May - 30 April**. All swimmers, coaches, committee member and officials must re-register through their club each year in order to have current membership coverage so as not to be placed at risk.

Swimming Victoria has a Duty of Care to advise:

- Unregistered swimmers are not permitted to compete in any sanctioned SVI meet.
- Unregistered swimmers have limited cover under our Personal Accident and Public Liability coverage if they have an accident at a club function or activity.
- Committee members must be registered. Decisions made by club executive members and officials could be considered negligent if they are unregistered at the time of decision.
- Decisions made by unregistered officials/Directors of the club will not be covered by our Directors/Clubs Indemnity Insurances and you may be personally liable for any damages claim that may result out of your actions.
- Clubs have a Duty of Care to ensure that all participants are protected under our Insurance Coverage.
