RULES:

1. Swimmers may contest a maximum of 4 events per night
2. Eligibility: Swimmers must contest 3 of the 4 meets to be eligible for any trophy
3. Starting will be over the top when required. Electronic SAT timing will be used
4. Age as at the 28th May 2011
5. No Swimmer will be permitted to swim out of their age group
6. Swimming Victoria REGISTERED SWIMMERS ONLY may compete
7. The meet will run under the ONE START rule (with exception of the 25m events)
8. Entries MUST be on SV Entry Forms (complete with correct details) or TM file
9. Organisers are under NO OBLIGATION to amend incorrect entries (please be careful)

POINTS SCORE: All times at all 4 meets are accumulated for each event.

A swimmer must place in the top 5 places in an event by the end of the 4th meet to gain points.

Each swimmer can only place in any event once.

Points awarded 1st=6pts, 2nd=4pts, 3rd=3pts, 4th=2pts and 5=1pt. The highest combined point scorer in each age group (not each event) at the END OF THE 4th MEET will be declared the winner.

Any queries regarding the scoring system should be raised prior to the start of the 1st meet.
